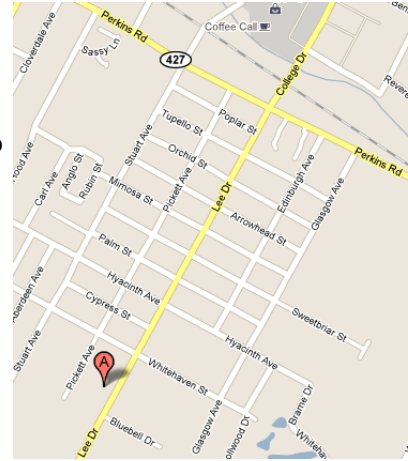


Kendal and Amy Keifner — Saturday only

Come and see how these creative pond owners added incredible curb appeal to the front yard! The pond spans the entire length of the house and backs up directly to the front porch.

The homeowner collaborated to design this hidden retreat in the middle of Southdowns. When you are looking at this pond, including waterfalls, streams, a bridge, landscaping and fish, you would never think you were in the city!



A stone trail behind the waterfall invites you to meander around the pond and enjoy it from all sides. In addition to the pond, the owners invite you to visit their newest addition, a backyard entertainment space, inspired in the wake of Hurricane Gustav. The homeowner will be available to answer all your questions regarding their fabulous outdoor living areas. A representative from The Deep South Koi and Pond Society will also be available to discuss the club, ponds and fish.

Directions: From the intersection of Perkins and Lee, go down Lee Drive toward Highland Road; pass Hyacinth and Whitehaven. The house is on the right, four houses down from Lee High School. (If you pass Lee High, you have gone too far.)



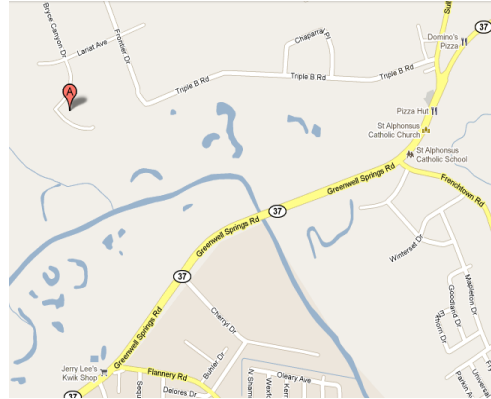
Charles Williams and Pattie Murray - Sunday Only

6718 Bryce Canyon Drive, South, Greenwell Springs, LA 70739

The pond was built in 2006 to the owners' specifications. Charles and Pattie are bird watchers and wildlife lovers. Therefore, the pond was designed with ample flowing water including two waterfalls, as well as shallow areas attractive for nesting and migrating birds.

Charles and Pattie have observed over 70 species of birds and 15 kinds of nesting birds in their yard. The pond's overall dimensions are 35' by 20' and contains about 2800 gallons of water. The owners have added a few koi and are members of the Deep South Koi and Pond Society. The homeowners will be available to answer questions.

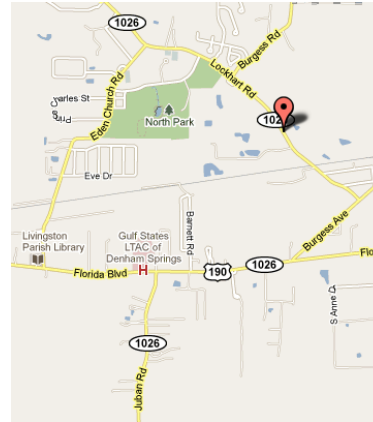
Directions: Greenwell Springs Road to Sullivan; go 100'; turn left on Triple B by Chase Bank. Follow Triple B/Frontier Road one mile; turn left on Lariat; left on Bryce Canyon. The house is at the corner of Bryce Canyon Drive and Bryce Canyon Drive South.



Michael and Ann Simmers (Saturday & Sunday)

10087 Lockhart Road, Denham Springs, LA 70726

This pond was originally dug 70 years ago. Four years ago, the homeowners redid the pond to make it 9 feet deep. The pond is ½ acre and holds just over 300,000 gallons of water. It has a natural clay bottom, the same type of environment breeders use to grow young koi. Approximately 400 koi of every size and even more goldfish live in the pond.



Two acres of manicured paths and gardens, with raised flower beds, a 5 tier water fall, a stone terrace overlooking the pond, a turtle paddock and arched bridge to the island are just some of the additional highlights. This fabulous outdoor living space is a 14 year project completed by the owners. The Simmers will be available to answer questions and share the details of their efforts.

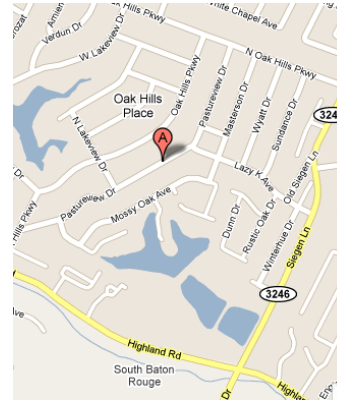
Directions:

From I-12 take Juban Road exit to US 190 (Florida Blvd.); turn right on Florida Blvd. then left on LA1026/1027 (Chevron station at intersection); at 3 way stop sign take left on LA1026 Lockhart Road; first house on right past the railroad tracks

Charbel and Ruth Harb (Saturday & Sunday)

841 Pastureview, Baton Rouge, LA 70810

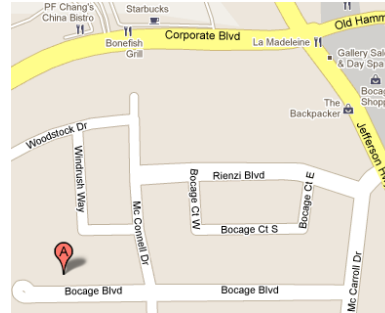
An 11' x 16' pond with two streams and waterfalls create a relaxing retreat for the owners of Harb's Oasis garden center. Surrounded by a deck, a flagstone path, a wooden bridge and a swing in the shade; the pond and landscaped area take up the entire backyard. An abundance of tropical and blooming plants, colorful foliage and trees are intermingled with chirping birds, darting hummingbirds, fluttering butterflies and dragonflies. The Harbs' three grandsons take great pleasure in helping to feed the koi and goldfish. The homeowner will be available to answer questions during the tour.



Directions: Take Siegen Lane past Perkins south to North Oak Hills Parkway and turn right. Turn left onto Pastureview; pass stop sign; house is on the right.
